Defendant's consent

It is recommended that you seek legal advice prior to signing this consent form.

I confirm that the Murri Court process has been explained to me, including that I am expected to:

- talk to the Murri Court Elders about my personal circumstances, needs and goals for the future;
- engage with treatment and support services I am referred to by the Murri Court Elders and community justice group;
- tell the court about my attendance and engagement with treatment and support services I am referred to; and
- appear before the Murri Court magistrate for sentence.

I understand that:

- the Department of Justice and Attorney-General (DJAG) is collecting my personal information on this form to determine my eligibility to participate in Murri Court;
- if I am referred to Murri Court, I am required to contact the community justice group to arrange an appointment to speak with the Murri Court Elders about my personal circumstances;
- the community justice group will collect my personal information to assist the Murri Court Elders and Murri Court magistrate understand my cultural and personal circumstances and ongoing support needs;
- the community justice group will provide information collected about me to treatment and support services to which I am referred to assist them in understanding my personal circumstances and providing ongoing support;
- the community justice group will provide information collected about me to DJAG for the purpose of evaluating the Murri Court;
- my personal information will be stored securely and only released where relevant to the operation of Murri Court;
- the Murri Court magistrate may take my participation in Murri Court into account at sentence;
- if I fail to attend appointments with service providers to whom I am referred, this information may be provided to the Murri Court;
- if I do not comply with all reasonable directions of the community justice group and service providers in the context of Murri Court, my matter may be re-mentioned for the court to consider whether my bail should be varied or revoked.

I consent to:

- a referral to the Murri Court assessment panel to determine whether or not I am suitable to participate in Murri Court;
- my legal representative sharing information regarding my current and prior offending with the community justice group;
- DJAG sharing information regarding my current State Penalties Enforcement Registry (SPER) debt and payment plan with the community justice group;
- the Murri Court assessment panel sharing information about me and discussing my circumstances with my legal representative/duty lawyer, the prosecution, Queensland Corrective Services, Youth Justice, the Murri Court magistrate and service providers I am referred to, for the purpose of supporting my involvement in Murri Court and treatment/support;
- the support service agencies I am referred to providing a written report to the community justice group coordinator regarding:
 - o my goals and progress;
 - o my attendance at appointments, and, where I do not attend, reasons for my non-attendance (when known);
 - o the service provider's satisfaction with my attendance and engagement with the service;
 - o alternative or additional support the service provider believes I require.
- my personal information being used for evaluation purposes where my anonymity is assured.
