PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 1C OF 2004

Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999

Rule 975B of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* defines “**approved entity**” as meaning an entity that—

(a) is either—

- (i) a solicitor or firm of solicitors; or
- (ii) an entity approved by a practice direction to have documents electronically filed; and

(b) has an agreement with a service provider for the service provider to electronically file a document for the entity.

For the purposes of rule 975B(a)(ii) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*,

Credit Collection Services Australia,
Binks Bottomley & Co., Pty Ltd; and
Benchmark Mercantile

are approved to have documents electronically filed under this practice direction.
