## **PRACTICE DIRECTION 3 of 2011**

Additional Applicant Information and Statutory Declaration for the Land Court (AISD) in relation to: Mining Claims, Mining Leases or Additional Surface Areas of Land for Mining Leases

(Form 3)

- 1. This Practice Direction repeals and replaces Practice Direction 6 of 2009.
- 2. The purpose of this Practice Direction is to ensure that the Court's procedures for dealing with applications under the *Mineral Resources Act 1989* for mining claims, mining leases or additional surface areas of land for mining leases (where there are objections) are as simplified and expeditious as possible.
- 3. To that end, where there are objections, each applicant is required to:
  - a) complete Form 3 (AISD); and
  - b) within five (5) business days after the last day for the receipt of objections for the application:
    - i) lodge form 3 with the mining registrar (at whose office the application was lodged) for forwarding to the Court;
    - ii) provide a copy to each objector.
- 4. Use of this form is intended to:
  - a) supplement the application (which applicants are reminded should be completed in a detailed and meaningful way); and
  - b) assist in reducing the number of Court directions hearings that may be required.
