Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999

The Uniform Civil Procedure Amendment Rule (No.1) 2003 was made by the Governor in Council on 15th May 2003.

The Rule amends Part 1 of Chapter 22 of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999, by inserting a new Division 4 – Electronic Court documents (Rules 975A to 975I).

The purpose of the Rule is to enable the electronic filing of documents in Magistrates Courts.

For the purpose of Rule 975C(1)(c), in addition to those registries listed at item 4 of the Magistrates Courts Practice Direction 1 of 2003, and registries listed in Magistrates Courts Practice Direction 1B of 2005, documents may also be filed electronically at the following Magistrates Courts registries:
