MAGISTRATES COURTS

PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 1 OF 2003

The Uniform Civil Procedure Amendment Rule (No. 1) 2003, was made by the Governor in Council on 15th May 2003.

The Rule amends Part 1 of Chapter 22 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, by inserting a new Division 4 – Electronic court documents (Rules 975A to 975I).

The purpose of the Rule is to enable the electronic filing of documents in Magistrates Courts.

- 1. For the purposes of rule 975B, CITEC CONFIRM is approved as the service provider.
- 2. For the purposes of rule 975B, Metropolitan Collection Agency; Logan City Council; and George Laurens (G.C.) Pty., Ltd. are approved as approved entities
- 3. For the purpose of rule 975C(1)(b), the documents which may be filed electronically are:

Claim (Form 2); Minor Debt Claim (Form 3); Statement of Claim (Form 16); Request for Default Judgment (Form 25); and Affidavit (form 46).

- 4. For the purpose of rule 975C(1)(c), the registries at which documents may be filed electronically are the Magistrates Courts registries at:
 - Beenleigh; Brisbane – Central; Bundaberg; Caboolture; Cairns; Gladstone; Gympie; Holland Park;

Inala; Ipswich; Mackay; Maroochydore; Rockhampton; Southport; Toowoomba; Townsville.
