## Practice Directions - No. 24 of 1994

## Appearance of public trustee at applications for criminal compensation

Subject to any direction by the Judge hearing an application for criminal compensation where the estate of a prisoner vests in the Public Trustee, it shall be sufficient for the Public Trustee to file an affidavit informing the Court that the prisoner has advised the Public Trustee that he/she wishes to take no part in the proceedings, without the need for the Public Trustee to appear in Court upon the hearing of such an application.
