

Bryce Kassulke and Paddy Kassulke both of 52-54 Bartle Road, Mount Tamborine in the State of Queensland apply to the Planning and Environment Court at Brisbane for the following orders:-

- That Condition 1 of the Development Approval of his Honour Judge Quirk made on the 5th June 1995 be changed to read "development being undertaken generally in accordance with Plan No. 7500-S1 to 7500-S4 except insofar as it is modified by the conditions of this approval and by drawing S005-0205 which provides for the relocation of the barbecue area from the eastern side of the existing building to the southern side of the existing building".

The grounds relied on are:

An application was submitted to Beaudesert Shire Council on the 2nd June 1995 seeking to rezone the subject property from the Rural zone to a Special Facilities zone allowing the Applicant to establish a Tourist Facility incorporating the following uses:

- wine tasting and sales facility;
- a restaurant/refreshment service;
- the sale of local arts and crafts; and
- six (6) tourist accommodation cabins.

During the designated advertising period, the application received a number of submissions from the local community.

The application was considered at Council's Ordinary Meeting held on the 29th September 1995 where it was refused. The grounds for refusal are set out below.
