REFERENCES

1. In any reference to the Mental Health Court, where a party to the proceeding wishes oral evidence to be called in the proceeding:
 - (a) at least 21 days prior to that hearing, the party who has filed the reference is to file with the Registry, and serve on all other parties, a list of the issues in dispute and the findings which ought to be made in respect of each such issue; and
 - (b) at least 14 days prior to that hearing, each other party to the reference is to file with the Registry, and serve on all other parties, a list of the issues in dispute and the findings which ought to be made in respect of each such issue.
2. Such documents are not to exceed three pages in length, except with the leave of the Mental Health Court.
