Electronic filing of documents - *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*

- 1. The *Uniform Civil Procedure Amendment Rule (No.1) 2003* was made by the Governor in Council on 15 May 2003.
- 2. The Rule amends Part 1 of Chapter 22 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, by inserting a new Division 4 Electronic Court documents (Rules 975A to 975I).
- 3. The purpose of the Rule is to enable the electronic filing of documents in Magistrates Courts
- 4. For the purpose of Rule 975C(1)(b), in addition to those documents listed at item 3 of the Magistrates Courts Practice Direction 1 of 2003, the following documents may also be filed electronically:

Application (in a proceeding) (Form 9);
Default Judgment (Form 26); and
Enforcement Hearing Summons (Form 70)
