Practice Direction No. 18 of 2012

Electronic filing of documents – *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*

1. The *Uniform Civil Procedure Amendment Rule (No.1) 2003* was made by the Governor in Council on 15 May 2003.
2. The Rule amends Part 1 of Chapter 22 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, by inserting a new Division 4 – Electronic Court documents (Rules 975A to 975I).
3. The purpose of the Rule is to enable the electronic filing of documents in Magistrates Courts
4. For the purpose of Rule 975C(1)(b), in addition to those documents listed at item 3 of the Magistrates Courts Practice Direction 1 of 2003, the following documents may also be filed electronically:

Application (in a proceeding) (Form 9);
Default Judgment (Form 26); and
Enforcement Hearing Summons (Form 70)
