


PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 26 OF 2014

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

CHANGE OF ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

1. As of 3 November 2014, the address of the Brisbane office of Thynne & Macartney will change to Level 19, Central Plaza Two, 66 Eagle Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000.
2. A party to a proceeding who prior to 3 November 2014 has been and continues thereafter to be represented by Thynne & Macartney is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service.
3. For the purpose of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules*, as from and including 3 November 2014, the party's address for service will be taken to be the address specified in paragraph 1.
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any such proceeding, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of address. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
