## NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. On 20 January 2018, the name of the firm then known as Moloney MacCallum Lawyers changed to Moloney MacCallum Abdelshahied Lawyers. The firm's service address has not changed.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 20 January 2018 had been represented by Moloney MacCallum Lawyers, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Moloney MacCallum Lawyers to Moloney MacCallum Abdelshahied Lawyers.
- 3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 20 January 2018:
  - (a) service of a document addressed to "Moloney MacCallum Lawyers" at the firm's address at 4/100 Scarborough Street, Southport, Queensland, 4215, will be taken to be service upon "Moloney MacCallum Abdelshahied Lawyers" at that address; and
  - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Moloney MacCallum Lawyers" is to be taken to be a reference to "Moloney MacCallum Abdelshahied Lawyers".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
