Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999

Rule 975B of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* defines "approved entity" as meaning an entity that-

- (a) is either-
 - (i) a solicitor or firm of solicitors; or
 - (ii) an entity approved by a practice direction to have documents electronically filed; and
- (b) has an agreement with a service provider for the service provider to electronically file a document for the entity.

For the purposes of rule 975B(a)(ii) of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999,

Australian Pacific Commercial Recoveries Pty Ltd trading as Backtracker Investigations

is approved to have documents electronically filed under this practice direction.
