PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 2 OF 2003

Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999

Part A – Designation of Court Holidays – Magistrates Courts Registries

Rule 976 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* provides that the Registry must be open on each day other than a Saturday, Sunday or Court holiday. For the purposes of that rule, and in relation to the Magistrates Courts Registries, I designate the period 25 December to 1 January inclusive, as court holidays.

Part B – Designation of Court Holiday 2004 – Magistrates Courts Registries

Rule 976 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* provides that the Registry must be open on each day other than a Saturday, Sunday or Court holiday. For the purposes of that rule, and in relation to the Magistrates Courts Registries, I designate the 2nd January, 2004 as court holiday. This Part is to be read in conjunction with Part A of the Practice Direction.
