

PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 4 OF 2016

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

1. On 1 February 2016, the name of the firm previously known as KPMG Legal and Tax Services changed to KPMG Law. The firm's address has not changed.
2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service as defined in Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)*, a party to a proceeding who prior to 1 February 2016 had been, and continued thereafter to be, represented by KPMG Legal and Tax Services, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from KPMG Legal and Tax Services to KPMG Law.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules*, as from and including 1 February 2016:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "KPMG Legal and Tax Services" at the firm's address at 71 Eagle Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000, will be taken to be service upon "KPMG Law" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "KPMG Legal and Tax Services" is to be taken to be a reference to "KPMG Law".
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
