Practice Direction No. 5 of 2009

Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999

Rule 975B of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* defines “approved entity” as meaning an entity that-

- (a) is either-
 - (i) a solicitor or firm of solicitors; or
 - (ii) an entity approved by a practice direction to have documents electronically filed; and
- (b) has an agreement with a service provider for the service provider to electronically file a document for the entity.

For the purposes of rule 975B(a)(ii) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*,

BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY (PORTABLE LONG SERVICE LEAVE) AUTHORITY, and

CONTRACT CLEANING INDUSTRY (PORTABLE LONG SERVICE LEAVE) AUTHORITY

are approved to have documents electronically filed under this practice direction.
