Court practice notes

Bail undertakings and notices to appear

These matters are to be listed for 9:00am on a relevant Monday or Friday.

Mid-week in custody matters are to be listed at times arranged with the Registrar or court staff in consultation with the Magistrate.

Duty Lawyers

Duty lawyer days are every Monday and Friday.

An on-call duty lawyer will be available for mid-week new in custody matters only at 9:00am on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
