Practice Direction No. 30 of 2012

Bail applications by remote communication device - Maroochydore and Caboolture Magistrates Courts

- The purpose of this Practice Direction is to provide, in accordance with section 15B
 of the Bail Act 1980 (the Act), for the making of Bail applications by remote
 communication device under section 15A of the Act in circumstances as specified in
 this Direction.
- 2. This Practice Direction applies only to bail applications made during the period or and from 2 January 2013 to and including 21 December 2013.
- 3. It applies to bail applications made by persons located with Marcochy Were, Gympie, Kingaroy and Caboolture Magistrates Courts Districts to a magistrate constituting a Magistrates Court at one of the Old king locations.

Maroochydore and Caboolture

- 4. This Practice Direction provides for the paking of an application for bail if the requirements set out above are met and the chromstances mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (c) apply:
 - (a) a police office has refused to grant bail to a person under section 7 of the Rail Act 1940 lonan offence; and
 - (b) a Magistrates Court is pathorised under the Act to grant bail to the person for the orence, and
 - (c) Paying regard to all the circumstances, the person may not reasonably or places ably be brought personally before a court.
- 5. Acting a accomance with this Practice Direction the person may apply under section 134 of the Act to a magistrate for bail for the offence by telephone, video or by another form of communication (a remote communications device), whether or put that section would otherwise apply.
- 6. A magistrate will be available to constitute a Magistrates Court at Maroochydore in order to facilitate the making of applications under this Direction and to hear other matters between the hours of 8.30am and 11am on Saturdays falling on or between the following dates:
 - 5 January 2013 to 12 January 2013 inclusive
 - 2 February 2013 to 23 February 2013 inclusive
 - 13 April 2013 to 29 June 2013 inclusive
 - 17 August 2013 to 2 November 2013 inclusive
 - 21 December 2013

and on the following Public Holidays:

- 25 April 2013 ANZAC Day
- 17 May 2013 Gympie Show Holiday
- 10 June 2013 Queen's Birthday Holiday
- 14 June 2013 Nambour Show Holiday
- 07 October 2013 Labour Day Holiday

- A magistrate will be available to constitute a Magistrates Court at **Caboolture** in order to facilitate the making of applications under this Direction and to hear other matters between the hours of 9am and 11am on Saturdays falling on or between the following dates:
 - 19 January 2013 to 26 January 2013 inclusive
 - 2 March 2013 to 6 April 2013 inclusive
 - 6 July 2013 to 10 August 2013 inclusive.
 - 9 November 2013 to 14 December 2013 inclusive

and on the following Public Holidays:

28 January 2013 Australia Day Holiday

Good Friday 29 March 2013 01 April 2013 Easter Monday

12 August 2013 Caboolture & Kingaroy Show
