

PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 20 OF 2015

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

CHANGE OF NAME FOR SERVICE

1. As of 1 October 2015, the name of the firm currently known as Rostron Carlyle Solicitors will change to Rostron Carlyle Lawyers. The firm's address will not change.
2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 1 October 2015 has been represented by Rostron Carlyle Solicitors is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Rostron Carlyle Solicitors to Rostron Carlyle Lawyers.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 1 October 2015:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "Rostron Carlyle Solicitors" at the firm's address at Level 15 Adelaide Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000, will be taken to be service upon "Rostron Carlyle Lawyers" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Rostron Carlyle Solicitors" is to be taken to be a reference to "Rostron Carlyle Lawyers".
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
