

Practice Directions - No. 3 of 2000

Uniform Civil Procedure Rules

Part A

Designation of Court Holidays - Supreme Court Registry

Rule 976 of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules provides that the Registry must be open on each day other than a Saturday, Sunday or court holiday. For the purposes of that rule, and in relation to the Supreme Court Registry, I designate the days following Christmas Day, up to and including New Year's Eve, as court holidays.
