REFERENCES

- 1. If an officer of the Mental Health Court Registry is concerned that a reference of the matter of a defendant's mental state to the Mental Health Court does not comply with the requirements of the *Mental Health Act 2016* (Qld) (s 101, 110, 111) or practice direction number 2 of 2019, then the officer is to refer the reference (and any material accompanying it) to a judge of the Mental Health Court, with a request for instruction about whether to accept the reference or list the matter for review at the next callover.
- 3. If the judge decides that the registry ought to accept the reference, the registry will be instructed accordingly.
- 4. Otherwise, the matter will be listed for hearing at the next call-over of Mental Health Court matters.
