

## Admission – Notice to practitioners

When applying for the admission of an applicant the traditional form of words should be used as follows:

“If the court pleases, I apply for the admission of (Ms/Miss/Mrs/Mr/Dr) ABC as a legal practitioner. Ms ABC holds the degrees of \_\_\_\_\_ from the University of \_\_\_\_\_; has completed the required practical legal training at (the College of Law); has complied in all respects with the rules relating to admission and holds the recommendation of the Board.”

It is permissible for a practitioner to mention in addition a family relationship (DO NOT REFER TO THE APPLICANT IN A PERSONAL WAY, SUCH AS “MY DEAR FRIEND”); the circumstances that the applicant is or has been a judge’s associate, naming the judge; and high academic distinction (e.g. graduation with Honours, University Medal).
