SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME AND ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

1. As of 27 August 2020, the name of the firm previously known as S J Gurnsey and Company changed to Rostron Carlyle Rojas Lawyers. The firm's address also changed to Level 15, 270 Adelaide Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000.
2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service as defined in Rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)*, a party to a proceeding who prior to 27 August 2020 was, and continues thereafter to be, represented by S J Gurnsey and Company, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from S J Gurnsey and Company to Rostron Carlyle Rojas Lawyers.
3. For the purpose of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 27 August 2020:
 - (a) the party's address for service of a document will be taken to be the address specified in paragraph 1 of this practice direction;
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
