*Mental Health Act 2000 Queensland
Section 426*

- ◆ A person must not contravene a confidentiality order unless the person has a reasonable excuse.
Maximum penalty— 40 penalty units.

PLEASE PRINT

The Mental Health Court may, by order, prohibit or restrict the disclosure to the person the subject of a proceeding of—

- ◆ information given before it; OR
- ◆ matters contained in documents filed with, or received by, it; OR
- ◆ the reasons for its decision in the proceeding

Confidentiality order

PLEASE PRINT

The Mental Health Court may make a confidentiality order only if it is satisfied the disclosure would—

- ◆ cause serious harm to the health of the person; OR
- ◆ put the safety of someone else at serious risk
