NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. On 30 June 2020, the name of the firm then known as Travis Schultz Law changed to Travis Schultz and Partners. The firm's service address has not changed.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* (1999) refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 30 June 2020 had been represented by Travis Schultz Law, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Travis Schultz Law to Travis Schultz and Partners.
- 3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 30 June 2020:

will be taken to be service upon "Travis Schultz and Partners" at that address; and

- (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Travis Schultz Law" is to be taken to be a reference to "Travis Schultz and Partners".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
