

Practice Directions - No. 27 of 1999

Registrar Powers to Hear Applications for Admission

The Registrar of the Supreme Court may constitute the Supreme Court to hear and decide applications for registration as a barrister/solicitor of the Supreme Court in accordance with the mutual recognition principle pursuant to the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Act 1999.

This direction relates to Rule 452(2)(b) of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules.
