NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. As of 19 December 2014, the name of the firm currently known as Reliance Lawyers will change to CLH Lawyers. The firm's address will not change.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 19 December 2014 has been represented by Reliance Lawyers is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Reliance Lawyers to CLH Lawyers.
- 3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)*, as from and including 19 December 2014:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "Reliance Lawyers" at the firm's address at Level 7, 515 St Pauls Terrace, Fortitude Valley, Brisbane, Queensland, 4006, will be taken to be service upon "CLH Lawyers" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Reliance Lawyers" is to be taken to be a reference to "CLH Lawyers".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
