SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

APPLICATIONS FOR EXCUSAL FROM JURY SERVICE

- 1. This Practice Direction specifies criteria for applications for excusal from jury service under s 21(1)(f) of the *Jury Act 1995* (the Act).
- 2. For the purpose of s 21(1)(f) of the Act, in deciding whether to excuse a person from jury service, the Sheriff must have regard to whether:
 - a. jury service would be contrary to or incompatible with a genuine religious belief or conscientious position held by the person;
 - b. jury service would result in substantial financial hardship to a business which employs the person.
- 3. For the purposes of s 21(1)(f) of the Act, a person seeking excusal must provide appropriate documentary evidence to support his or her application for excusal.
