## NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. On 1 June 2022, the name of the firm then known as The Personal Injury Lawyers changed to TPIL Lawyers. The firm's service address has not changed.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who, prior to 1 June 2022 had been represented by The Personal Injury Lawyers, is relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from The Personal Injury Lawyers to TPIL Lawyers.
- 3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, from 1 June 2022:
  - (a) service of a document addressed to "The Personal Injury Lawyers" at the firm's address at Level 6, 33 Elkhorn Avenue, Surfers Paradise, Queensland 4271 will be taken to be service upon "TPIL Lawyers" at that address; and
  - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "The Personal Injury Lawyers" is to be taken to be a reference to "TPIL Lawyers".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
