

PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 3 OF 2011

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

CHANGE OF ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

1. As of 1 May 2011, the name of the firm DLA Phillips Fox will change to DLA Piper Australia. The firm's address will not change.
2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 1 May 2011 has been represented by DLA Phillips Fox is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change in the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from DLA Phillips Fox to DLA Piper Australia.
3. For the purposes of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules, as from and including 1 May 2011:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "DLA Phillips Fox" at the firm's address will be taken to be service upon "DLA Piper Australia" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "DLA Phillips Fox" is to be taken to be a reference to "DLA Piper Australia"
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any such proceeding a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of address. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
