PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 5 of 2015

PROVISION OF DRAFT ORDERS

- 1. In any proceeding in the Mental Health Court where all parties to the proceeding have agreed that no oral evidence will be called in the proceeding, the legal representative for the Director of Mental Health is to provide:
 - (a) to all other parties to the proceeding, a copy of a draft order or set of draft orders, in the approved form prior to the commencement of the hearing; and
 - (b) to the Court, a copy of a draft order or set of draft orders, in the approved form, capable of being signed by the Mental Health Court.
- 2. If any other party to the proceeding does not agree with the terms of the draft order or set of orders proposed by the Director of Mental Health, that party is to provide the Court with an alternate draft order or set of draft orders, in the approved form, capable of being signed by the Mental Health Court.
