NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. On 1 November 2022, the name of the firm then known as Ready Hocking Law and RH Law changed to RHR Legal. The firm's service address has not changed.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service to which rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* (1999) refers, a party to a proceeding who, prior to 1 November 2022 had been represented by Ready Hocking Law and RH Law, is relieved of the obligation under rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Ready Hocking Law and RH Law to RHR Legal.
- 3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, from 1 November 2022:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "Ready Hocking Law" or "RH Law" at the firm's address at Level 9, 420 George Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000 will be taken to be service upon "RHR Legal" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Ready Hocking Law" or "RH Law" is to be taken to be a reference to "RHR Legal".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
