Practice Direction No. 6 of 2023

Repeal – Practice Direction 29 of 2012 - Changes of Address for Service in accordance with Practice Directions of the Supreme Court

- 1. On 28 March 2023 Chief Justice Bowskill gave notice that as from Monday, 3 April 2023, the Chief Justice will no longer issue practice directions in relation to changes in the name and/or address of a solicitor or a solicitor's firm.
- In accordance with that notice Magistrates Courts Practice Direction No.29 of 2012

 Changes of Address for Service in accordance with Practice Directions of the Supreme Court, is repealed.
- 3. Rule 17(3) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* 1999 (UCPR) provides that a notice of any change in a party's address for service must be filed and served on all other parties.
- 4. Where the name and/or address of the solicitor or solicitor's firm has changed, and that name and/or address forms part of the address for a party under r 17 of the UCPR, the party is relieved of the obligation under r 17(3) on and from the date of issue of a Practice Direction by this Court informing the change.
