PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 8 OF 2010

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

ELECTRONIC FILING OF APPLICATIONS UNDER THE CRIMINAL ORGANISATION ACT 2009

- 1. This Practice Direction applies to applications made under the *Criminal Organisation Act 2009* by the Commissioner of the Queensland Police Service (the applicant).
- 2. For the purposes of rule 967(1)(c) *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* (UCPR), supporting affidavits for such applications may be filed in an electronic format using an electronic storage device, including but not limited to a compact disc (CD) or digital video disc (DVD).
- 3. The electronic storage device must be marked with the proceeding name and number, or leave sufficient space for the proceeding number to be inserted.
- 4. The material on the electronic storage device must be compatible with standards defined by the Courts which are published on the Queensland Courts website.
- 5. The applicant must arrange with the Registrar to test that the material can be played back in Court prior to a hearing.
