

PRACTICE DIRECTION NUMBER 8 OF 2010

SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

**ELECTRONIC FILING OF APPLICATIONS UNDER THE
*CRIMINAL ORGANISATION ACT 2009***

1. This Practice Direction applies to applications made under the *Criminal Organisation Act 2009* by the Commissioner of the Queensland Police Service (the applicant).
2. For the purposes of rule 967(1)(c) *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* (UCPR), supporting affidavits for such applications may be filed in an electronic format using an electronic storage device, including but not limited to a compact disc (CD) or digital video disc (DVD).
3. The electronic storage device must be marked with the proceeding name and number, or leave sufficient space for the proceeding number to be inserted.
4. The material on the electronic storage device must be compatible with standards defined by the Courts which are published on the Queensland Courts website.
5. The applicant must arrange with the Registrar to test that the material can be played back in Court prior to a hearing.
