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# **REPORT ON THE OPERATIONS OF THE LAND TRIBUNAL ESTABLISHED UNDER THE ABORIGINAL LAND ACT 1991 FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2008**

## **I INTRODUCTION**

1. This is the seventeenth annual report on the operations of the Land Tribunal established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*. The report covers the period from 1 July 2007 to 30 June 2008.
2. The report deals with the membership of the Land Tribunal, land claim proceedings during this year, the status of all claims received by the Tribunal to date, an overview of aspects of the operation of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* and various administrative matters.

## **II THE LAND TRIBUNAL**

### **(a) Membership**

3. The *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* (the Act) provides for the establishment of a Land Tribunal comprising:
  - (a) a Chairperson, who is appointed on a part-time or full-time basis;
  - (b) such number of Deputy Chairpersons as are appointed on a part-time basis; and
  - (c) such other Members as are appointed on a part-time basis.
4. The Chairperson and each Deputy Chairperson is a presiding Member of the Tribunal. Each presiding Member is a lawyer.
5. Each non-presiding Member must:
  - (a) have, in the opinion of the Governor in Council, suitable knowledge of Aboriginal people or Aboriginal tradition; or

- (b) have had experience, for not less than 5 years, at a high level in industry, commerce, public administration, industrial relations, the practice of a profession or the service of a government or an authority of a government.
6. By notice dated 19 July 2001, and published in the Queensland Government Gazette on 20 July 2001, the Governor-in-Council appointed me, Carmel Anne Catherine MacDonald, as part-time Chairperson of each of the Land Tribunals established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* and the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* for a term of seven years from 30 July 2001. I was also appointed as a full-time Member of the Land Court for a term of 15 years from 30 July 2001.
7. By notice dated 14 October 2004 and published in the Government Gazette dated 15 October 2004, the Governor in Council reappointed the following Deputy Chairpersons and Members of the Land Tribunal for a term of 3 years from 10 November 2005 to and including 9 November 2008 -

8. By notice published in the Government Gazette dated 19 July 2007, the Governor in Council reappointed Ronald Graham Wright PSM as a Member of the Land Tribunal from 20 July 2007 to and including 9 November 2008.
9. By notice published in the Government Gazette dated 14 September 2007, the Governor in Council appointed the Deputy Chairpersons, Ms Jean Dalton and Mr Stephen Keim, as part-time Members of the Land Court on and from 13 September 2007 to and including 9 November 2008.

**(b) Functions**

10. The function of the Land Tribunal was to receive claims made by groups of Aboriginal people to areas of claimable land, hear claims to that land, and report to the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland in relation to each claim.
11. On 22 December 2006, s.48 of the *Aboriginal Land Act* came into operation. Section 48 provides that a claim under the Act must be made not later than 15 years after the commencement of s.45. Section 45 commenced on 21 December 1991. Accordingly, no new claims have been received by the Tribunal since 22 December 2006.
12. On 2 November 2007, most of the provisions of the *Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act 2007* came into effect. The objects of that Act are (a) to identify significant natural and cultural values of Cape York Peninsula, (b) to provide for cooperative management protection and ecologically sustainable use of land, including pastoral land, in the Cape York Peninsula Region, (c) to identify the economic, social and cultural needs and aspirations of indigenous communities in relation to land in the Cape York Peninsula Region and (d) to recognise the contribution of the pastoral industry in the Cape York Peninsula Region to the economy and land management in the region.
13. The *Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act* effected substantial amendments to the *Aboriginal Land Act*. Relevantly, s.83L was introduced into the *Aboriginal Land Act*. Section 83L applies to claimable land in the Cape York Peninsula Region other than claimable land that is transferred land or claimable land for which the Land Tribunal had made a recommendation to the Minister before the section commenced. Section 7(1) of the *Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act* provides that the Cape York Peninsula Region is the area identified as such on Map 1 Cape York Peninsula Region prepared and held by the Department of Natural Resources and Water. The map is available on that department's website. The only two of the then outstanding land claims not affected by the enactment of s.83L are the Aboriginal Land Claims to Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) National Park and Cedar Bay National Park.
14. Section 83L(2) provides that on the commencement of the section the land to which the section applies is transferable land for the purposes of the Act, the land stops being claimable land, any proceeding before the Land Tribunal in relation to a claim for the land ends and the provisions in the Act as to the hearing and determination of claims stop applying to the land.
15. The result of this legislation is that, with the exception of the claims to Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) National Park and Cedar Bay National Park all of the claims to land that had not been heard and determined by the Tribunal as at 2 November 2007 have now ended and the Tribunal no longer has any function to hear those claims and report to the Minister concerning them.

**(c) Land claim procedures**

16. Previous annual reports have discussed a number of matters relating to land claim procedures, including parties to land claim proceedings, representation of parties, the location of land claim hearings, group evidence, restriction of evidence, and the recording of proceedings. Further information about procedures is found in land claim reports. It is not necessary to repeat what was said in those reports.
17. The Tribunal's Practice Directions were published in the 1992 Annual Report and have not been amended in any substantial way. They are available from the registry upon request.

**III LAND CLAIMS**

**(a) Claimable land and land claims**

18. Since establishment, sixty claims were referred to the Tribunal up to and including 22 December 2006.

19. A table giving details of the land claimed and the claimants is Annexure A to this report.
20. Nineteen new land claims were referred to the Tribunal in December 2006. Those claims were advertised as required by the Act between 6 August and 12 October 2007.
21. A table setting out the details of advertising and exhibition of each land claim application, the parties, hearing and report information, Ministerial decisions and land granted, is Annexure B to this report.

**(b) Tribunal Proceedings**

22. Following applications by the Cook Shire Council, the Chairperson ordered on 24 October 2007 that the Council become a party to each of the claims lodged in December 2006.

23. On 6 September 2007 and 27 June 2008, teleconferences were held in regard to the claims to Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) National Park. No funding is available to enable the claims to proceed to hearing.
24. A teleconference was conducted by the Chairperson on 25 June 2008 in respect of the claim to Cedar Bay National Park – the remaining Aboriginal land claim proceeding in the Cape York Peninsula area. This claim is not in a position to proceed to a hearing.

**(c) Land claim reports**

25. There are no new publications of Aboriginal land claim reports.

30. Section 83J of the *Aboriginal Land Act* (which was inserted into that Act by the *Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act 2007*) applies to land for which the Land Tribunal has made a recommendation to the Minister where the land is or includes part of a national park in the Cape York Peninsula Region. The section provides that before the national park is granted the land trust for the land must enter into an indigenous management agreement with the State about the management of the national park land. The grant of the national park land is subject to a condition that the national park land must become a national park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land). The requirements as to the content of an indigenous management agreement are set out in s.83G of the Act and include matters such as a statement as to how the land is proposed to be managed, the responsibilities of the grantees of the land in relation to the land, details of the process for developing a management plan for the land and the areas of land to which general public access may be restricted.
31. Those sections apply to the following land which the Tribunal had recommended be granted – Cape Melville National Park, Flinders Group National Park, Clack Island National Park, Lakefield National Park, Cliff Islands National Park, Iron Range National Park, Mungkan Kandju National Park, Mitchell-Alice Rivers National Park and Starcke National Park.

**(g) Status of all land claims**

32. As noted above, most of the remaining claims before the Tribunal were terminated on 2 November 2007 and the land the subject of those claims becomes transferable land by virtue of the operation of s.83L of the Act.
33. The provisions of s.83J apply to such transferable land if it is or includes part of a national park in the Cape York Peninsula Region with the same consequences as are set out in [30].
34. The following Table (pages 8 and 9) and Maps (pages 10 and 11) set out the status and location at 30 June 2008 of all land claims.


## LAND CLAIMS RECEIVED PRIOR TO DECEMBER, 2006

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## **IV LEGISLATION**

35. As at 30 June 2008, the current published reprint of the *Aboriginal Land Act* was Reprint No. 6. The current electronic reprint was Reprint No. 6C which includes amendments in force as at 2 November 2007.
36. Those parts of the *Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act 2007* (No. 48 of 2007) which amend the *Aboriginal Land Act* came into effect on 2 November 2007. The effect of the Cape York Peninsula Heritage Act on the claims process is discussed above.
37. The *Aboriginal Land Act* was also amended in a minor respect by the *Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2007* (No. 36 of 2007), which came into effect on 29 August 2007. The amendment does not affect the claims process.

## **V ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

### **(a) Staff**

38. The full-time staff of the Land Tribunal comprises a Senior Deputy Registrar (Mr Kevin Hayden) and an Executive Assistant (Ms Glenda Jones). Those officers also serve the Land Tribunal established under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* and the Land Court. I thank them for their assistance and support.

### **(b) Relationship with the Land Court and other Tribunals**

39. During the year covered by this report, I sat as a Member of the Land Appeal Court and the Land Court. Ms Jean Dalton SC conducted a directions hearing as a member of the Land Court on 19 December 2007 and Mr Stephen Keim SC conducted a preliminary conference as a member of the Land Court on 19 February 2008.
40. Pursuant to s.15 of the *Land and Resources Tribunal Act 1999*, the Chairperson and each Deputy Chairperson of the Land Tribunal who are members of the Land Court is a Land Court non-presiding member of the Land and Resources Tribunal and may hear a proceeding and make a decision as a single member constituted Tribunal (s.39). Neither of the Deputy Chairpersons nor myself have sat in this capacity.

41. Similarly, each member of the Aboriginal Land Tribunal becomes a Land Tribunal non-presiding member of the Land and Resources Tribunal (s.15) and may constitute a panel for the purpose of hearing and making a decision in a proceeding in that Tribunal (s.39). No member of the Aboriginal Land Tribunal sat on a panel in a Land and Resources Tribunal proceeding in the 2007/2008 period.

**(c) Administrative arrangements**

42. As at 30 June 2008 the following Administrative Arrangements were in place in respect of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*:

the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland is responsible for administering ss.50 to 62, Part 8; ss.134 and 138 as they apply to the provisions of the Act administered by the Minister;

the Minister for Sustainability, Climate Change and Innovation is responsible for administering s.83(2)-(11); s.134 (as it applies to the provisions of the Act administered by the Minister); and

the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland is responsible for administering the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* except to the extent administered by the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland, and the Minister for Sustainability, Climate Change and Innovation.

43. Pursuant to the above arrangements, the Tribunal reports annually on its operations to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland. Reports on Aboriginal land claims under the Act are provided to the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland.

**(d) Budget**

44. This Tribunal and that established under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* together with the Land Court form part of the Justice Administration Output of the Department of Justice and Attorney-General. The Tribunals and the Land Court share accommodation.

45. Both Tribunals' costs for the financial year in question were \$157,770 excluding accommodation charges.

46. No fees were paid to the part-time Members of the Tribunal.

**(f) Statement of Affairs**

48. Section 129(1) of the Act obliges the Chairperson of the Land Tribunal to prepare and give to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice an annual report on the operation of the Tribunal.

49. The *Freedom of Information Act 1992* requires public authorities to publish annually an up-to-date statement of affairs. Most of the matters to be contained in such a statement are covered in this annual report. In accordance with s.18 of the *Freedom of Information Act*, and in the absence of a separate statement of affairs as at 30 June 2007, I make the following observations:

- (a) The Land Tribunal's structure and functions are described at paragraphs 3 to 17 above.
- (b) The functions of the Land Tribunal could affect members of the community when land is claimed pursuant to the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*. The Tribunal has advertised each claim made and invited persons whose interests could be affected by the grant of the land claimed to apply to be made a party to the land claim proceeding. The Tribunal generally holds its land claim hearings in public. If the Tribunal recommends the grant of the land claimed, the Tribunal advises the Minister on each of the matters mentioned in paragraph 12 of this report. The consequences (if any) of land claims for the community are documented in the Tribunal's land claim reports.
- (c) To a large extent, the way in which the Tribunal operates is prescribed by the Act. The Tribunal has a broad discretionary power in relation to the conduct of proceedings before the Tribunal (see, for example ss.108 and 119 of the Act). There are no ongoing arrangements to enable members of the community to participate in the formulation of the Tribunal's policy and the exercise of the Tribunal's functions.

- (d) Each land claim application is available for public inspection at the Tribunal's offices and other specified venues. Other documents, including the Tribunal's Practice Directions, land claim reports and annual reports, may also be inspected at the Tribunal's offices.
  - (e) The Tribunal arranges for the publication of each annual report. After the report is tabled in the Legislative Assembly, copies of the report can be obtained, free of charge from the Tribunal. Apart from the Bulletins (mentioned in paragraph 25), Practice Directions (mentioned in paragraph 14) and land claim reports (mentioned in paragraph 26), no other literature is available, either by way of subscription services or free mailing lists.
  - (f) There are no boards, councils, committees or other bodies that are a part of, or that have been established for the purpose of advising the Tribunal.
- (g)&(h) Generally speaking, the Tribunal does not hold documents concerning the personal affairs of members of the community. Consequently, it has not been necessary to make arrangements for access to and correction of such documents. Some documents which contain personal information are made available to the Tribunal as exhibits in land claim proceedings. People mentioned in such documents have an opportunity to correct them in the course of a hearing. Often, the documents are received subject to restrictions on future access to and use of them. Such restrictions are imposed under s.110 of the Act.
- (i) Similarly, it has not been necessary to make a reading room or other facility available for use by members of the community.

## **VI CONCLUDING REMARKS**

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# **REPORT ON THE OPERATIONS OF THE LAND TRIBUNAL ESTABLISHED UNDER THE TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER LAND ACT 1991 FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2008**

## **I INTRODUCTION**

1. This is the fourteenth annual report on the operations of the Land Tribunal established under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*. The report covers the period 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009.

## **II THE LAND TRIBUNAL**

### **(a) Membership**

2. The *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* (the Act) provides for the establishment of a Land Tribunal comprising:
  - (a) a Chairperson, who is appointed on a part-time or full-time basis;
  - (b) such number of Deputy Chairpersons as are appointed on a part-time basis; and
  - (c) such other Members as are appointed on a part-time basis.
3. By notice dated 19 July 2001 and published in the Queensland Government Gazette on 20 July 2001 the Governor in Council appointed me, Carmel Anne Catherine MacDonald, as part-time Chairperson of each of the Land Tribunals established under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* and the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* for a term of seven years from 30 July 2001. I was also appointed as a full-time Member of the Land Court for a term of 15 years from 30 July 2001.
4. No appointments were made to the Tribunal during the period covered by this report.

**(b) Functions**

5. The functions of the Tribunal were to receive claims made by Torres Strait Islanders to areas of claimable land, to hear claims to that land and to report to the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland in relation to each claim.
6. In December 2006, s.45 of the Act came into operation. Section 45 provides that a claim under the Act must be made not later than 15 years after the commencement of s.45 of the Act. Section 45 commenced on 21 December 1991. Accordingly no claims to land may now be made under the Act.

**III LAND AVAILABLE FOR CLAIM**

7. The Act provided a means by which claims could be made to claimable land in the Torres Strait area. The boundaries of the Torres Strait area are described in the Torres Strait Treaty, annex 9. A copy of the Treaty is set out in the schedule to the *Torres Strait Fisheries Act 1984* (Cth).
8. No land was declared to be available for claim under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*. Consequently, no land claims were referred by the Land Claims Registrar to the Tribunal.

**IV LEGISLATION**

9. As at 30 June 2008, the current reprint of the Act was Reprint No. 6A.
10. In the period covered by this report, the Act was amended in a minor way by the *Local Government and Other Legislation (Indigenous Regional Councils) Amendment Act 2007* (No. 59 of 2007) which came into effect on 15 March 2008.

## **V ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

### **(a) Staff**

11. The full-time staff of the Land Tribunal comprises a Senior Deputy Registrar and an Executive Assistant. Mr Kevin Hayden is the Senior Deputy Registrar. Ms Glenda Jones is the Executive Assistant. These officers also serve the Land Tribunal established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* and the Land Court. I thank them for their assistance and support.

### **(b) Relationship with other bodies**

12. In addition to the work as Chairperson of this Land Tribunal and the Land Tribunal established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*, I have undertaken work as a Member of the Land Appeal Court and the Land Court.

### **(c) Administrative arrangements**

13. As at 30 June 2007 the following Administrative Arrangements were in place in respect of the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*:

the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland is responsible for administering ss. 47 to 59; Part 8; ss. 131 and 135 as they apply to the provisions of the Act administered by the Minister;

the Minister for Sustainability, Climate Change and Innovation is responsible for administering s. 80(2)-(11); s. 131 as it applies to the provisions of the Act administered by the Minister; and

the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland is responsible for administering the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* except to the extent administered by the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland, and the Minister for Sustainability, Climate Change and Innovation.

14. Pursuant to these arrangements, the Tribunal reports annually on its operations to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland. Reports on Torres Strait Islander land claims

under the Act are to be provided to the Minister for Natural Resources and Water and Minister Assisting the Premier in North Queensland.

**(d) Budget**

15. This Tribunal and that established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* together with the Land Court form part of the Justice Administration Output of the Department of Justice and Attorney-General. The Tribunals and the Land Court share accommodation.
16. Both Tribunals' costs for the financial year in question were \$157,770 which excludes accommodation charges. Approximately \$2,000 of the Tribunals' costs constituted the expenditure by the Land Tribunal established under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*.

**(f) Statement of Affairs**

18. The *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991* requires the Chairperson of the Land Tribunal to prepare and give to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice an annual report on the operation of the Tribunal. The *Freedom of Information Act 1992* requires public authorities to publish annually an up to date statement of affairs. Most of the matters to be contained in such a statement are covered in this annual report.
19. In accordance with s.18 of the *Freedom of Information Act*, and in the absence of a separate statement of affairs as at 30 June 2007, I make the following observations:
  - (a) The Land Tribunal's structure and functions are set out at paragraphs 2, 5 and 6 above.

- (b) As the Land Tribunal no longer has any function to perform under the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*, it cannot affect members of the public.
- (c) There are no arrangements to enable members of the community to participate in the formulation of the Tribunal's policy and the exercise of the Tribunal's functions. To a large extent the way in which the Tribunal operates is prescribed by the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*.
- (d) The Tribunal holds few documents and has no register of claims or other such compilation of documents which is available for public inspection.
- (e) The Tribunal arranges for the publication of each annual report. After the report is tabled in the Legislative Assembly copies of the report can be obtained, free of charge, from the Tribunal. No other literature is available, either by way of subscription services or free mailing lists.
- (f) There are no boards, councils, committees or other bodies that are a part of, or that have been established for the purpose of advising the Tribunal.
- (g),(h) & (i) The Tribunal does not hold documents concerning the personal affairs of members of the community. Consequently, it has not been necessary to make arrangements for access to and correction of those documents.
