NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME AND ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

- 1. As of 1 July 2021, the name of the firm previously known as CRH Law changed to HopgoodGanim Lawyers. The firm's address also changed to Level 8, Waterfront Place, 1 Eagle Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000.
- 2. On the basis that the name of the firm forms part of the address for service as defined in Rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules* (1999), a party to a proceeding who prior to 1 July 2021 was, and continues thereafter to be, represented by CRH Law, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from CRH Law to HopgoodGanim Lawyers.
- 3. For the purpose of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 29 March 2021:
 - (a) the party's address for service of a document will be taken to be the address specified in paragraph 1 of this practice direction;
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "CRH Law" is to be taken to be a reference to "HopgoodGanim Lawyers".
- 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
