Defendant's on fresh Notice to Appear must attend court in person. Duty Lawyers are available for Adult and Children's criminal matters on callover days.

Lengthy Sentences that are expected to exceed 15 minutes in total won't be done on callover days and will be allocated a time and date for sentence.

All lengthy sentences, summary trials, contested police and private domestic violence applications, committals with cross-examination, directions hearings, applications to cross-examine, represented full hand-up committals with submissions, unrepresented full hand up committals and contested Peace and Good Behaviour applications will be allocated dates from the callovers to be done on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays of Warwick sitting weeks
