

## NOTICE TO THE PROFESSION

## CHANGE OF CONTACT DETAILS AND ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

## (rule 17(3) of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999)

From Monday, 3 April 2023, the Chief Justice will no longer issue practice directions in relation to changes in the name and/or address of a solicitor or solicitor's firm.

Where the name and/or address of the solicitor or solicitor's firm has changed, and that name and/or address forms part of the address for service of a party under r 17 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999* (UCPR), <u>notice</u> of the change to the party's address for service must be filed in each proceeding to which it applies and served on all parties to that proceeding, as required by r 17(3) of the UCPR.

The notice may be <u>filed by email</u>, in accordance with the <u>Principal Registrar (Supreme and District Courts) – Approval 1 of 2020</u> (updated on 28 March 2023).
