SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

1. On 20 September 2017, the name of the firm then known as Fenton O’Shea Law changed to Lexsolve Lawyers. The firm’s service address has not changed.
2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 20 September 2017 had been represented by Fenton O’Shea Law, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party’s address for service consequent upon the change of name from Fenton O’Shea Law to Lexsolve Lawyers.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 20 September 2017:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to “Fenton O’Shea Law” at the firm’s address at 2/16 Douglas Street, Milton, Queensland, 4064, will be taken to be service upon “Lexsolve Lawyers” at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to “Fenton O’Shea Law” is to be taken to be a reference to “Lexsolve Lawyers”.
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
