DISTRICT COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

1. On 22 October 2018, the name of the firm then known as Cronin Litigation Lawyers changed to Cronin Miller Litigation. The firm's service address has not changed.
2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 22 October 2018 had been represented by Cronin Litigation Lawyers, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Cronin Litigation Lawyers to Cronin Miller Litigation.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 22 October 2018:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "Cronin Litigation Lawyers" at the firm's address at Level 2, 33 Elkhorn Avenue, Surfers Paradise, Queensland, 4217, will be taken to be service upon "Cronin Miller Litigation" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Cronin Litigation Lawyers" is to be taken to be a reference to "Cronin Miller Litigation".
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
