SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

1. On 1 November 2019, the name of the firm then known as McNamara and Associates changed to McNamara Law. The firm's service address has not changed.
2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(4) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 1 November 2019 had been represented by McNamara Associates, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(3) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from McNamara and Associates to McNamara Law.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 1 November 2019:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "McNamara and Associates" at the firm's address at:
 - (i) Unit 10, 88 Limestone Street, Ipswich, Qld, 4305; or
 - (ii) 11 William Street, Gatton, Qld 4343; or
 - (iii) GE HQ Building, 6 Yoga Way, Springfield, Qld 4300,will be taken to be service upon "McNamara Law" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "McNamara and Associates" is to be taken to be a reference to "McNamara Law".
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
