SUPREME COURT OF QUEENSLAND

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

1. On 3 July 2019, the name of the firm then known as Harris Law changed to Resolve Estate Law. The firm's service address has not changed.
2. On the basis that the name of the practice forms part of the address for service to which Rule 17(6) of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules (1999)* refers, a party to a proceeding who prior to 3 July 2019 had been represented by Harris Law, is hereby relieved of the obligation under Rule 17(5) to file and serve notice of change of the party's address for service consequent upon the change of name from Harris Law to Resolve Estate Law.
3. For the purposes of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 1999*, as from and including 1 July 2019:
 - (a) service of a document addressed to "Harris Law" at the firm's address at Level 7, 320 Adelaide Street, Brisbane, Queensland, 4000, will be taken to be service upon "Resolve Estate Law" at that address; and
 - (b) a reference in a document filed prior to that date to "Harris Law" is to be taken to be a reference to "Resolve Estate Law".
4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
