I INTRODUCTION

1. This is the twenty-third annual report on the operations of the Land Tribunal established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*. The report covers the period from 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2014.
2. The report deals with the membership of the Land Tribunal, land claim proceedings during this year, the status of all claims received by the Tribunal to date, an overview of aspects of the operation of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* and various administrative matters.

II THE LAND TRIBUNAL

3. The Tribunal was established on 21 December 1991, the date of commencement of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*.

(a) Membership

4. The *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* (the Act) provides for the establishment of a Land Tribunal comprising:
 - (a) a Chairperson, who is appointed on a part-time or full-time basis;
 - (b) such number of Deputy Chairpersons as are appointed on a part-time basis; and
 - (c) such other Members as are appointed on a part-time basis.
5. The Chairperson and each Deputy Chairperson is a presiding Member of the Tribunal. Each presiding Member is a lawyer.
6. Each non-presiding Member must:
 - (a) have, in the opinion of the Governor in Council, suitable knowledge of Aboriginal people or Aboriginal tradition; or

- (b) have had experience, for not less than 5 years, at a high level in industry, commerce, public administration, industrial relations, the practice of a profession or the service of a government or an authority of a government.
7. By notice dated 17 August 2012, and published in the Queensland Government Gazette on 17 August 2012, the Governor in Council reappointed me, Carmel Anne Catherine MacDonald, as the part-time Chairperson of the Land Tribunal established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* for a term of two years from 17 August 2012 to 16 August 2014. I was appointed as a full-time Member of the Land Court for a term of 15 years from 30 July 2001 and as President of the Court from 1 August 2008 for the balance of my term as a Member.
8. By notice dated 17 August 2012, and published in the Government Gazette on 17 August 2012, Mark Douglas Evans was appointed as a part-time Deputy Chairperson of the Land Tribunal from 17 August 2012 to 16 August 2014.
9. There were no persons appointed as Members of the Tribunal during the year under review.

(b) Functions

10. Until 22 December 2006, the Land Tribunal received claims made by groups of Aboriginal people to areas of claimable land. No new claims have been received by the Land Tribunal since that date because of the operation of s 60 of the Act (previously s 48) which provides that claims must be made under the Act not later than 15 years after the commencement of the Act.
11. The only outstanding proceedings before the Tribunal are the claims to Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) National Park. The Tribunal has an ongoing function to hear those claims and to report to the Minister for Natural Resources and Mines in relation to them.

(c) Land claim procedures

12. Previous annual reports have discussed a number of matters relating to land claim procedures, including parties to land claim proceedings, representation of parties, the location of land claim hearings, group evidence, restriction of evidence, and the recording of proceedings. Further information about procedures is found in land claim reports. It is not necessary to repeat what was said in those reports.
13. The Tribunal's Practice Directions were published in the 1992 Annual Report and have not been amended in any substantial way. They are available from the registry upon request.

III LAND CLAIMS

(a) Claimable land and land claims

14. Sixty claims were referred to the Tribunal up to and including 22 December 2006.

16. A table setting out the details of advertising and exhibition of each land claim application, the parties, hearing and report information, Ministerial decisions and land granted, is Annexure B to this report.

(b) Tribunal Proceedings

17. No land claim hearings have been conducted by the Tribunal in the year under review.

18. *Boodjamulla (Lawn Hill) proceedings*: Directions hearings were held by the Chairperson in these matters on 9 August 2013, 23 August 2013, 11 October 2013, 28 February 2014 and 30 May 2014. Two of the claimant groups are not legally represented and those claimants are experiencing difficulty in marshalling statements of evidence and witnesses. The Chairperson is seeking to move the proceedings towards a hearing as soon as possible.

(c) Land claim reports

19. There have been no new publications of Aboriginal land claim reports.

(e) Status of claims determined by the Land Tribunal

22. At the date of this report, the Land Tribunal had recommended the grant of freehold title in respect of each of the claims about which it had presented reports. The Minister has accepted the Tribunal's recommendations in relation to every report so far provided.
23. Two grants of Aboriginal freehold title to successfully claimed land have been made in the reporting period¹ –

On 27 November 2013, an area of 172,914 hectares (inclusive of the former Cape Melville National Park, Flinders Group National Park (being an amalgamation of Flinders Group and Clack Island National Parks), Howick Group National Park and six islands being North Barrow Island, Rocky Point Island, Hales Island, Wedge Rocks, Boulder Rock and Cape Rock) was granted as Aboriginal freehold land to the Cape Melville, Flinders & Howick Islands Aboriginal Corporation. Parts of the granted area were subsequently declared as National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) in accordance with the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*. A recommendation for the grant of the land (save and except for Howick Group National Park, which was not the subject of any land claim) had been made by the Tribunal to the Minister in May 1994.

On 27 November 2013, an area of 181,886 hectares (formerly Starcke, Jack River, Melsonby (Gaarraay) and Mount Webb National Parks) was granted as Aboriginal freehold land to the Buubu Gujin Aboriginal Corporation. These areas were subsequently declared as National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) in accordance with the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*. A recommendation for the grant of the land comprising Starcke National Park had been made by the Tribunal to the Minister in December 2006.

(f) Status of all land claims

24. The following Table (pages 6 and 7) and Maps (pages 8 and 9) set out the status and location of all land claims as at 30 June 2014.


LAND CLAIMS RECEIVED PRIOR TO DECEMBER, 2006





Legend: Cape York Peninsula Region
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
LAND CLAIMS RECEIVED IN DECEMBER, 2006

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IV LEGISLATION

25. As at 30 June 2014, the current reprint of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* included amendments in force as at 28 March 2014.
26. During the reporting period, the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* was amended by the following legislation –
- (i) the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Land Holding Act 2013* (No. 2 of 2013);
 - (ii) the *Treasury and Trade and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2013* (No. 39 of 2013); and
 - (iii) the *Nature Conservation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (No. 2) 2013* (No. 55 of 2013).

The amendments effected by these Acts did not affect the claims process.

V ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

(a) Staff

27. The part-time staff of the Land Tribunal comprises the Senior Deputy Registrar (Mr Jeff Hobson) and an Executive Assistant (Ms Glenda Jones). Those officers also serve the Land Court. I thank them for their assistance and support.

(b) Relationship with the Land Court

28. During the year covered by this report, I presided over numerous hearings in the Land Court and sat as a Member of the Land Appeal Court.

(c) Administrative arrangements

29. As at 30 June 2014, the following Administrative Arrangements were in place in respect of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* pursuant to the *Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2013* (as amended):

the Treasurer and Minister for Trade is responsible for administering Part 18 of the Act to the extent that it is relevant to royalties;

the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice is responsible for administering sections 62 to 73; Part 19; sections 286 and 294 as they apply to the provisions of the Act administered by the Minister and

relevant sections relating to the Land Tribunal, Land Court, Land Appeal Court and Supreme Court;

the Minister for Natural Resources and Mines is responsible for administering the Act, except to the extent administered by the Treasurer and Minister for Trade; the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice; and the Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and Multicultural Affairs and Minister Assisting the Premier;

the Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and Multicultural Affairs and Minister Assisting the Premier is responsible for administering the Act to the extent that it is relevant to the transfer of land as Aboriginal land prior to the dedication of national parks (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal land) under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* and associated transfers of land as Aboriginal land.

30. Pursuant to the above arrangements, the Tribunal is to report annually on its operations to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and provide reports on land claims to the Minister for Natural Resources and Mines.

(d) Budget

31. The Tribunal and the Land Court form part of the Justice Services Division of the Department of Justice and Attorney-General. The Tribunal and the Land Court share accommodation.
32. The Tribunal's costs for the financial year in question were \$18,029.36.

(e) Accommodation

33. The registry of the Land Tribunal is located at level 8 of the Brisbane Magistrates Court building, 363 George Street, Brisbane.
