NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

- 1. On 1 July 2019, the name of the firm then known as Buckland Allen Criminal Lawyers Pty Ltd changed to Allen & Searing Criminal Lawyers Pty Ltd. The firm's service address has not changed.
- 2. - 4. It will not be necessary for the Registrar to place on the file for any proceeding referred to in paragraph 2, a copy of this practice direction or other notification of the change of name. The publication of the practice direction is itself deemed to be sufficient notification of the change.
