Practice Direction 4 of 2023

Notice under section 52 *Human Rights Act* 2019

- 1. This Practice Direction applies to proceedings in the Land Court of Queensland or Land Appeal Court where:
 - a. a question of law arises that relates to the application of the *Human Rights Act 2019*; and/or
 - b. a question arises in relation to the interpretation of a statutory provision in accordance with the *Human Rights Act 2019*

for the purposes of section 52 of the Human Right Act 2019.

- 2. Parties to the proceedings described above, must complete a Form 28 *Human Rights Act Notice*.
- 3. For the purposes of section 52 of the *Human Right Act 2019,* the Form 28 *Human Rights Act Notice* is the approved form.
- 4. A completed Form 28 *Human Rights Act Notice* is to be:
 - a. filed in the Land Court Registry;
 - b. served on the other party/s; and
 - c. served on the Attorney-General and Queensland Human Rights Commission.
- Where possible parties should communicate with each other to ensure only one Form 28 - *Human Rights Act Notice* is filed and served on the Attorney-General and Queensland Human Rights Commission.
